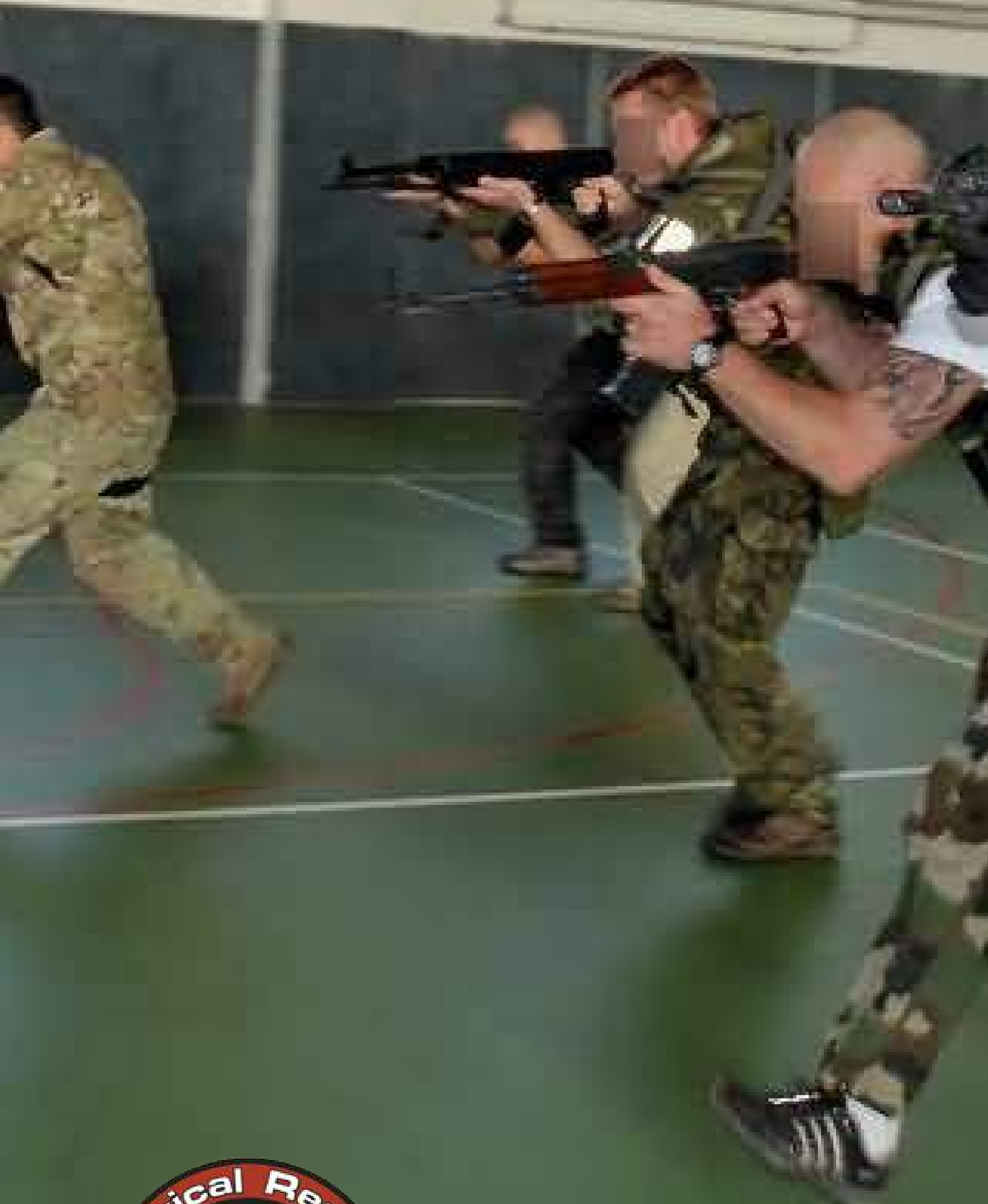


TCCC

Tactical Combat Casualty Care

The goal of the TCCC (Tactical Combat Casualty Care) program, established in 1996 from the civilian variant of pre-hospital care ATLS) was to server the best possible medical treatment under extreme conditions, achieved with limited material and personnel resources. At the same time, the highest command initiated the development of adequate medical devices and aids, with which even a relative medical layman would be able to keep the wounded alive for some, albeit limited time.
